



Easter Scavenger Hunt Pack

Just because we're in isolation doesn't mean we can't have fun! This pack includes 4 scavenger hunt options:

1. A get-out-of-the-house hunt around town, collecting photos
2. A photo-hunt based on the Easter story from the Bible
3. A simple hunt aimed at pre-schoolers/early readers, collecting items found on your own property
4. Clues for a traditional Egg Hunt (including space to add your own) for those wanting to hide their own eggs. Either hide an egg with each clue, or have the whole lot at the final location

Here are some ways to upgrade these hunts:

- ◆ Make it harder - drop the photo option and find actual objects to bring back (no taking without permission!)
- ◆ Make it EVEN harder - put a time limit on it
- ◆ Make it yum-er - hide eggs around town to go along with the more specific locations in Hunt 1
- ◆ Make it a contest—challenge another family to see who can find the most interesting stuff!
